

## Sean O'Hollaren

Senior Vice President, Global Government Relations



Sean O'Hollaren is Senior Vice President, Global Government Relations, for Honeywell International, with responsibility for leading the companywide Government Relations program. He leads the global function with offices in Washington, DC, Belgium, China, and India. In the U.S., Mr. O'Hollaren oversees Honeywell's policy advocacy efforts with Congress and the Executive Branch, as well as with state and local governments. He chairs the Honeywell Political Action Committee; he is also responsible for Honeywell's grassroots program.

Mr. O'Hollaren has held two roles at Honeywell prior to his current position. Most recently, following a year and a half in government, Mr. O'Hollaren served as Vice President, Government Relations, after serving in the White House as Deputy Assistant to the President for Legislative Affairs. In this position, he was the principal liaison between the White House and the United States Senate.

Preceding his position at the White House, Mr. O'Hollaren gained significant experience in both the public and private sector, which included serving as Senior Director of Government Relations for Honeywell.

Mr. O'Hollaren also served as Special Assistant to the President in the White House Office of Legislative Affairs, representing the President to the U.S. Senate on matters of transportation, commerce, energy, defense and the environment.

Prior to accepting his post at the White House and serving a brief period with the Department of Homeland Security, Mr. O'Hollaren was confirmed to the post of Assistant Secretary of Transportation, heading up the Office of Governmental Affairs at the U.S. Department of Transportation. Mr. O'Hollaren served during the creation of the Transportation Security Administration and its transition to the Department of Homeland Security.

Mr. O'Hollaren has nine years experience as the Director of Washington Affairs for Tax and Environment at the Union Pacific Corporation. He served former Oregon Senator Mark Hatfield from 1984 to 1991 in a number of capacities, including Staff Assistant and Legislative Assistant, before joining the Senate Appropriations Committee as a member of the Professional Staff.

Mr. O'Hollaren is a graduate of Willamette University in Oregon and has completed the Certificate program in Business Management at Georgetown University.

He and his wife Hilary live in Washington, D.C. with their three children, Rory, Seamus and Liam. Mr. O'Hollaren is an automobile enthusiast and also enjoys cycling, running, skiing and sailing.
